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## EirGrid and SONI: the two TSOs on the Island of Ireland have unique experience of cost-sharing

### • Experience relevant: two grids in one island synchronous system

- Island systems with AC interconnections between them and DC interconnection to GB. Future DC interconnection to France in planning.
- 16 years+ of cooperation for cost-sharing mechanisms but retain a level of independence
- Independently Inter TSO Compensation but broadly similar figures for losses etc.


#### World first's

- Dual currency multi-jurisdictional market (2007)
- Dual currency multi- jurisdictional generator Use of System (GTUoS) mechanism (2011)

#### Licence Obligation

- Licence obligation to cooperate to plan the systems
- Cost share on significant cross border CAPEX projects with WACC plus incentivization

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### EirGrid and SONI: the two TSOs on the Island of Ireland have unique experience of cost-sharing

#### Challenges

- Difficult to balance immediate and longer term priorities
- 4 different price controls covering at times interacting capital projects
- An increasingly IT based grid means heavy interaction between market and System Operations
  - this will be more relevant as time goes on
- 2 different jurisdictions part of larger political energy blocks (UK and EU)
- Very challenging and dynamic climate goals

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### EirGrid and SONI: the two TSOs on the Island of Ireland have unique experience of cost-sharing

#### **Experience**

- Simple ratio sharing has worked in the past
- RPI-X applied to OPEX with CAPEX having WACC
   & KPI incentivization
- Some project-specific cost-sharing arrangements
- Slightly different approaches taken by two regulators on the island to capex funding
- Importance of agreed approach for governance for programmes a key driver for successful cost-sharing
